Dear Math Team Sponsor:

This year's annual Jefferson College Math contest will be held **Tuesday, March 19th, 2024**. Please have your students bring **two (2)** sharpened #2 lead pencils.

NOTE: Calculators, cell phones or any electronic devices will NOT be permitted. Usage of either will result in elimination from the contest.

Time & Date: 9:00 a.m., Tuesday, March 19th, 2024

Place: Arts & Sciences I Building, Jefferson College, Hillsboro, MO

Middle School Team - consists of six (6) students (three each from grades 7 and 8)

High School Team – consists of twelve (12) students (three each from grades 9, 10, 11, 12)

Team members must be currently enrolled in the grades they are representing. Teams:

Additional Seniors are permitted to compete for the scholarship, but they may not be counted as part of the

team for purposes of the team score.

\$45 for high schools, and \$35 for middle schools, when registering in advance. Registrations that are not Fee:

completed by 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, March 12th, 2024, and/or registrations made the day of the event

will increase in price to \$90 for high schools, and \$70 for middle schools.

Up to two full-tuition scholarships to Jefferson College are awarded to the seniors with the highest scores. Scholarship:

Both team seniors and additional scholarship contestants are eligible.

Both tests will have 40 multiple choice questions with five (5) choices per question. Topics covered will

include:

Tests: Middle School: Arithmetic, Algebra, Geometry, Miscellaneous

High School: Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Trigonometry, Calculus, Math Analysis, Miscellaneous

Four (4) points for each correct answer; minus one (1) point for each incorrect response. No deduction is made for unanswered questions. The team score will be the total of the highest two (2) scores from each grade level. NOTE: All sponsors are required to report to the Hospitality Room in Arts & Science I room 207

at 11:00 a.m., after the test, to tabulate the results for their students and teams.

We will be having a small team competition in which students will work collaboratively on some more

challenging, less standard problems.

Due to logistic and personnel limitations, we won't be able to let everybody participate in the small team

challenge. Each High School and each Middle School team will be allowed one team of four students,

selected by whatever method you desire.

The competition will take place between 11:30 a.m. and 12:15 p.m. in the same building as the contest. Students should also have time to visit the Jefferson College Student Center for lunch between the end of

the competition and the award ceremony.

We will be serving pizza and bottled water (free to sponsors and the students) again this year in the cafeteria

in the Student Center. You are more than welcome bring your own lunch or we have a Micro-mart located in the Career & Technical Education (CTE) building to purchase some food and drink items. Please note you

will need a debit or credit card for purchases in the Micro-mart.
