

THE STORY

Lilli, a lonely, wide-eyed orphan, is enchanted with the desire to join the gay and glamorous carnival but is unsuccessful at several jobs with the troupe. The troupe, once successfully touring the small cities of France about a generation ago, is now raffish, run down, and third rate.

Lilli becomes the pawn in a fierce rivalry for her affection between Marco the Magnificent, the troupe's magician and Paul Berthalet, a puppeteer with a game leg. Paul talks through his puppets—the sentimental walrus who is fearful of 'antiwalrus' remarks, the sophisticated fox, a red-headed boy puppet, and a society lady. Still searching for her place in the darnival Lilli finally joins the puppet act. Her decision on which suitor to choose is the dramatic highlight of the play.
