The Set

The type of set used in this production is called a unit set. It is composed of moveable platforms, backdrops and pieces of scenery which merely suggest the various locales of the play. The unit set allows for rapid scene changes when there are multiple settings in a particular production. The set pieces are a juxtapositioning of the real and the non-real which correspond with the two worlds portrayed in the play.
