Synopsis

Sam Haskins, a turn-of-the-century, traveling photographer, arrives in Amesbury, a small Missouri town. He travels from town to town partially to avoid relationships that might result in more lasting commitments than he desires. Maggie Chandler, the proprietress of a rooming house and her great-niece Molly Forsey, a vibrant twelve-year-old, become uncomfortably important to Sam. He finds himself faced with decisions he had not expected and some of his actions cause anxiety in this typical small town. He is a salesman who believes in his product as is expressed in the theme song "Picture Book."
