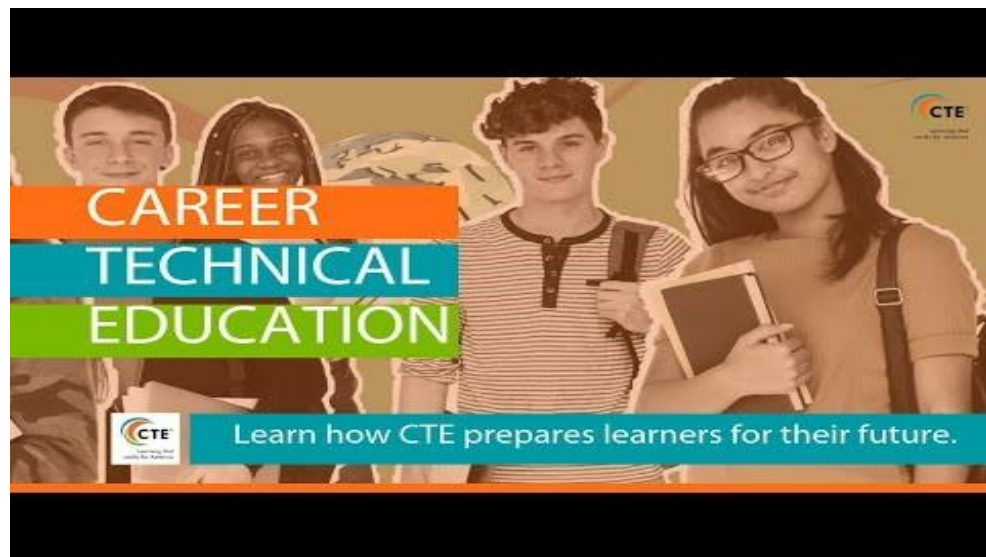


Congratulations and Welcome to the ATS

What is Career and Technical Education (CTE)?

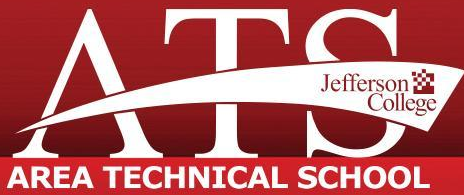
- The ATS is a state approved area career center. There are 57 in the state of Missouri and only 4 on college campuses

- High school programs: IEP/504 plans transfer smoothly to the ATS
- College programs: If a student has an IEP/504 plan and they want to access accommodations, they are required to complete a [ARO/Getting-Started - college Application](#) per college requirements before their accommodations can be reviewed and activated

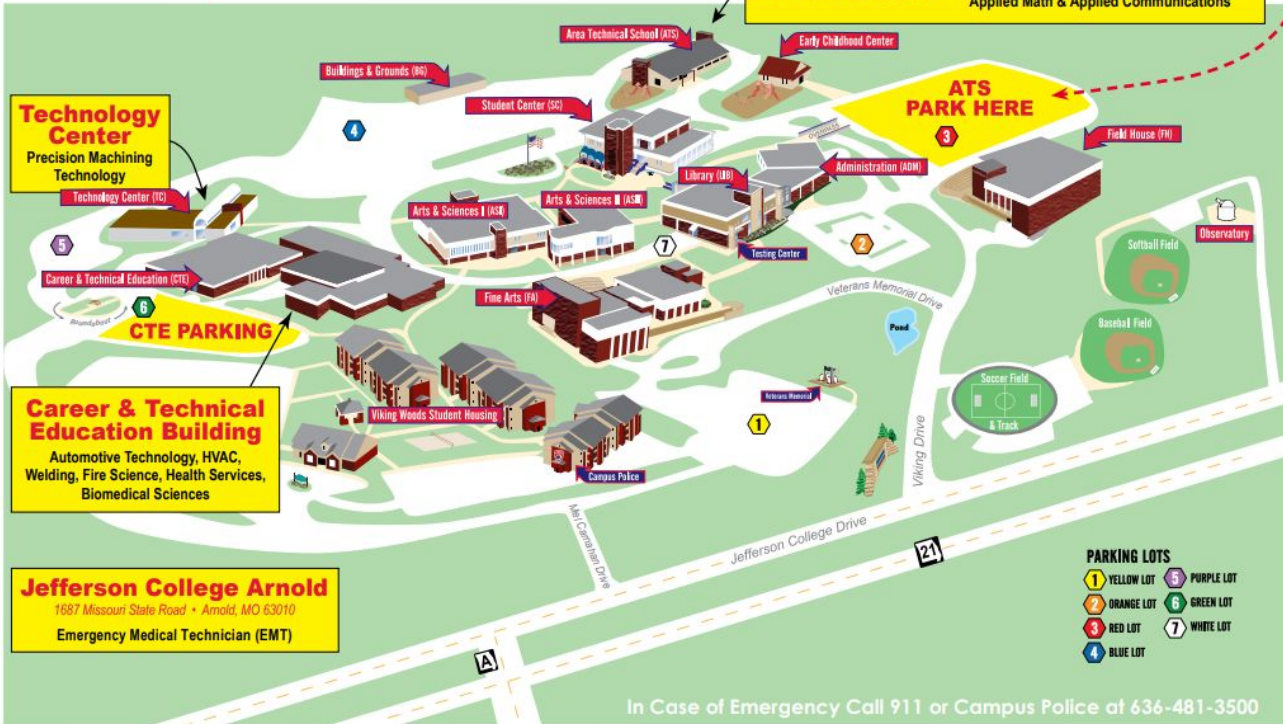

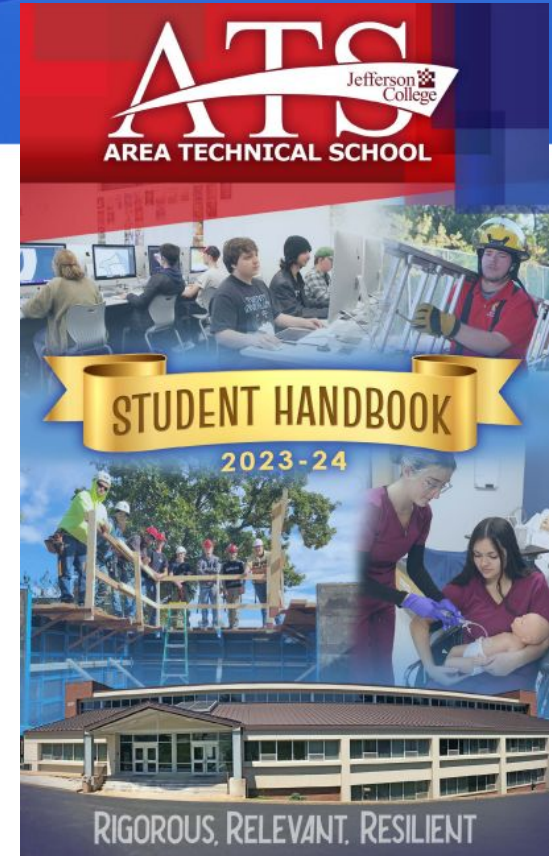

Rules, Policies, & Procedures

- Students will follow their sending school, Jefferson College and Area Technical School rules and policies
- Each student will receive the ATS Student Handbook at the start of the school year. Instructors will review the handbook with students
 - Parents should also review the entire handbook
- Parents and students are required to sign the annual acknowledgement form
 - Library/Internet Access, communications, handbook and other acknowledgements

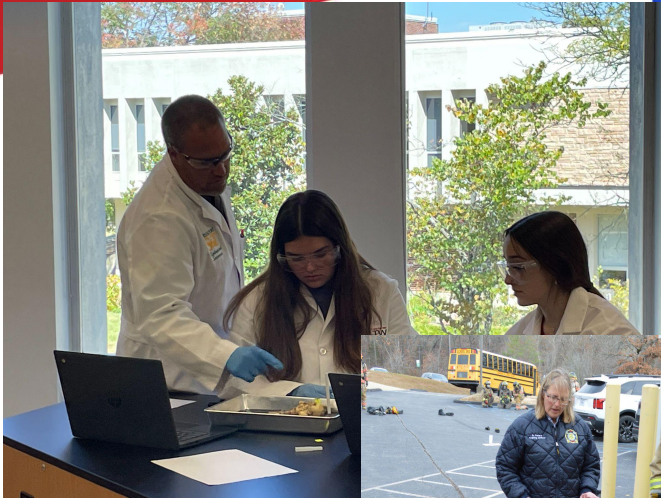


Rules, Policies, & Procedures continued

- Class Times
 - AM - 9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.
 - PM - 11:55 a.m. - 1:55 p.m.
- Transportation
 - Students are expected to ride the sending school transportation to the ATS.
 - ATS students may be allowed to drive on a case-by-case basis. The sending school and the ATS must approve any driving requests.
 - Students should not expect to drive to the ATS. Driving is a privilege that can be revoked.
 - Students with extenuating circumstances should work with their school counselor to complete a Driver/Parking permit.
 - Driving permits and Car Rider permits are available in the ATS office in the fall. Driving permits cost \$10.00.
 - Jefferson College Police Department enforces all parking rules and issues tickets.

Rules, Policies, & Procedures continued

- Attendance
 - Students are expected to attend the ATS each scheduled day.
 - If your sending school is not in session, but Jefferson College is in session, you should come to the ATS.
- Absences must be reported to your high school and the ATS office.
 - Parents/Guardians should call 636-481-3450 to report an absence.
 - Absences due to sending school events should be approved by the sending school and communicated to the ATS.
 - Snow Days - ATS will announce snow closures on social media, Viking Text, Remind, and emails to sending schools.
- Students can be dropped from the ATS due to lack of progress, excessive absenteeism, failing grades, or disciplinary issues.
- Students may not switch programs mid-year but can apply to another program for the next year.
