Tryout Clinic Information

The Tryout Clinics are specifically designed to help with the chant, cheer, and dance that will be used to help show your ability to learn quickly and be a team player. Coaches will be evaluating you on your spirit and appearance from the second you walk in the room; smile, be confident, and have fun! Participants also benefit by personally meeting with the coaching staff and learning first-hand information about the tryout process, upcoming season and schedule of events. *Participation in clinics is required for tryout eligibility; if you cannot make the below dates, please contact Coach Victoria for a private tryout.*

All clinics and tryouts will be held in the Field House at Jefferson College.

Clinic Requirements

To participate in the tryout clinics and tryout you must have:

1. Tryout Application
2. Signed Release Form - due at the first clinic you attend.
3. Unofficial transcripts to Coach Victoria.
4. Proper clinic attire:
 - a. Ladies: cheer shoes (tennis shoes if you do not have cheer shoes), athletic shorts and/or spandex, tshirt, & sports bra.
 - b. Men: tennis shoes, shorts, & tshirt.

Tryout Requirements

1. All requirements from clinic information above.
2. Tryout Appearance/Attire
 - a. Tryout participants may not wear apparel that identifies them with a particular squad or school. No high school, college, all-star squad apparel or competition shirts will be allowed. Generic apparel with the Jefferson College logo is recommended.
 - b. No jewelry of any kind is permitted at tryouts, tryout clinics, or any practice, appearance or performance throughout the year. These standards are in accordance with the USA Safety Rules, and following these rules at all times is mandatory.
 - c. Ladies: cheer shoes, white, or navy sports bra/t-shirt, red, gray, or black spandex/shorts, hair half up with a matching bow, make-up and lip color should project a collegiate image.
 - d. Men: white or navy t-shirt, red, navy, or black athletic shorts, Athletic/cheer Shoes, clean shaven.
 - e. Show enthusiasm and spirit throughout the tryout.

The above is required for participation in clinics and tryouts.. no exceptions.
