Exciting construction progress continues across campus:

Veterinary Technology Facility: The new building was approved for occupancy last week. Equipment and supplies have been moved from CTE to the new building and classes/labs will be beginning soon.

CTE Updates: The former Vet Tech space in the CTE building is being remodeled to make way for the Workforce and Employment Services staff and provide classrooms for non-credit training.



Both projects were made possible by **MoExcels grants** from the Missouri Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development.
