Course Description:

This training provides an overview of the major mental health conditions that law enforcement is likely to encounter. A description of each condition will be provided along with tips for law enforcement interaction with individuals experiencing that condition. Through an interactive experience, law enforcement will have the opportunity to experience psychosis and the challenges that it presents for individuals suffering from it. Law enforcement will provided with tools that will aid in making interactions with individuals easier and more efficient.

This training focuses on Autism Spectrum Disorder. Participants will gain knowledge about symptoms of Autism Spectrum Disorder, prevalence and risk factors. The presentation will also address safety issues and concerns for both the individual and law enforcement.
