Jefferson College Joins National Vaccine Challenge – Vaxxed Viking Clinics Set for August 24-25

With fall classes set to begin on August 23, Jefferson College has accepted the COVID-19 College Vaccine Challenge to build on efforts to get students, faculty/staff, and community members vaccinated.

The initiative, created by the White House and the U.S. Department of Education, invites colleges and universities across the country to join in furthering the efforts to end the pandemic. By taking part in the initiative, Jefferson College is committed totaking three key actions:

- Engage every student, faculty and staff member. Ensure every community member knows they are eligible for a vaccine and where to get one.
- Identify champions for vaccine efforts across campus and implement a plan to get as many campus community members vaccinated as possible.
- Provide vaccine access. Make it easy for students, staff and faculty to get vaccinated at sites near them this summer.

College officials say these priorities have been at the forefront of their COVID-19 response since the vaccine became available.

"Ensuring that all members of our campus community have access to a COVID-19 vaccine is just one of the many ways we have remained proactive throughout the pandemic," said Public Relations and Marketing Director Roger Barrentine. "Our students, faculty and staff have been incredibly supportive of our protocols put in place during the last academic year. I am confident that many either already have or soon will be fully vaccinated so that we can safely enjoy the coming school year."

To help make vaccines more accessible, the College will hold two free vaccine clinics the first week of the fall semester at the Arnold and Hillsboro campuses. The events are open to all students, faculty/staff, and community members with no appointment needed:

Those who get vaccinated or show proof of previous COVID-19 vaccination will be entered into drawings for gift cards, technology, and other prizes. Anyone that brings a friend who gets their vaccination during the clinics will receive an extra entry into the drawing.

The Moderna vaccine will be available to anyone over the age of 18. Recipients will receive additional information about a second dose. The Medicine Shoppe in DeSoto will provide the COVID-19 vaccinations.

There is no mandate for all students or employees to receive a COVID vaccination. The College recognizes the decision to receive the vaccine as a personal choice and will not discriminate against any student, employee or community member based on vaccination status.

Jefferson College Foundation Provides Resources for Welding Students' Learning Experience with NHRA Racing Champion Steve Torrence

This past May, the Foundation received a funding request from Maryanne Angliongto, Associate Dean, School of Math, Physics and Technology, to offset the cost of a rental car and hotel to provide several students in the Area Technical School Welding program a once-ina-lifetime learning opportunity. After hearing the details behind the funding application, the Foundation's Board of Directors unanimously approved the request:





It started with Professor Joe Candela creating a project for his ATS Welding students to build a fire pit for NHRA racing champion Steve Torrence, who Joe referred to frequently in his class as an example of someone who had overcome tragedies and difficulties to become successful in life. Once Steve received it, he reached out and set up one of his weekly Facebook Live events to talk with the class.

During the broadcast, Steve talked about his family's construction company, CAPCO, which specializes in the gas and oil industry, and when the majority of the students expressed that they dreamed of becoming pipeline welders, he invited them to come to Texas to see some of the projects CAPCO was working on. A few weeks later, Steve's wife reached out with a tentative trip literary and Candela calculated the cost of a rental vehicle and hotel rooms for five days.

This is a perfect example of the Foundation's work in fundraising to provide College programs the resources to make extraordinary educational experiences for our students.
