Natalie Pigg Selected as Jefferson College 2023 Alumna of the Year

The Jefferson College Faculty Senate recently announced Natalie Pigg of DeSoto as the 2023 Alumna of the Year during the annual Honors Recognition Ceremony. She was also recognized during the College's 58th annual commencement ceremonies held in May.

Alumnus of the Year Award recipients must have graduated from Jefferson College with a certificate or associate degree, achieved distinction in his/her chosen field of employment, been involved in community service; and not be a current trustee or an employee of Jefferson College.

Pigg currently serves as an Associate Attorney for Thurman Law Firm in the Family Law division and is a Crystal City Municipal Court Prosecuting Attorney. She previously worked as an Associate Attorney for The Lowry Law Firm.

"Jefferson College was my first glimpse into academic freedom. I was finally able to explore beyond the areas that had always been funneled to me up to that point," said Pigg. "While at Jefferson College, I spent a semester working on the Harbinger school newspaper and that interest in journalism turned me to the bigger world of politics and the law. I credit Professor Dedric Lee for that turn, which led me to get my bachelors in political science and eventually my law degree."

She graduated from Jefferson College with her Associate of Arts degree in 2007 and went on to earn a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science in 2009 from Webster University. Pigg's love of law drove her to pursue a Juris Doctor degree from Western Michigan University-Thomas M. Cooley Law School, where she graduated in 2015.

Natalie's service to our community is extensive. She is currently a board member for a Fighting Chance Foundation, the Mary Daniels Foundation, and is a member of PEO. She is President of Jefferson County Bar Association as well as Secretary for Jefferson County Women's Bar Association.

As part of the College's 2023 commencement ceremonies, Pigg reminded graduates of a statement by Winston L. Churchill, "Success is not final; failure is not fatal: It is the courage to continue that counts."


