Associate of Arts (AA) degree – A program of general studies designed for transfer to another college or university as part of a bachelor's degree. Save time and money by starting at Jefferson College!

Associate of Arts in Teaching (AAT) degree – Designed for education majors who plan to transfer to another college or university as part of a bachelor's degree. Those who want to become certified to teach Early Childhood, Elementary, Middle School, or Secondary Education should follow this course of study.

Associate of Science (AS) degree – Designed for engineering, engineering technology, and biological science students to transfer to a university as part of a bachelor's degree.

Associate of Fine Arts (AFA) degree – Designed for transfer to another college or university as part of a bachelor's degree in art or music.

Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree – Designed for entry-level employment through practical and theoretical courses. Choose from over 20 outstanding programs!

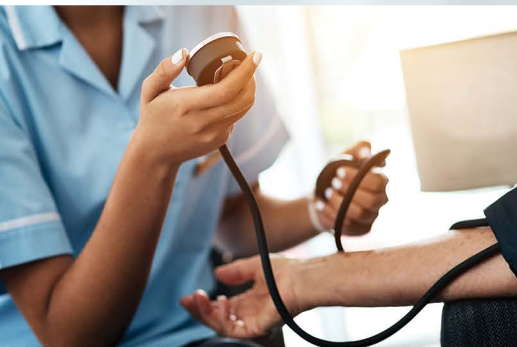

- 2** Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online: studentaid.gov

- 3** Send an official high school transcript or GED/HiSET certificate and any college transcripts to the Office of Admissions at:

- 4** Complete the ACCUPLACER Next-Generation placement test at the Jefferson College Testing Center or submit ACT results if needed.

- Students who graduated high school within the last five years with a GPA of 3.0 or higher may be exempt from placement testing.
- Students who previously completed the ACT or ACCUPLACER Next-Generation placement test within the last two years should check with the Office of Admissions after submitting those test scores to see if they still need to take the placement test.
- Students who have previously attended another accredited college should check with the Office of Admissions after submitting those transcripts to see if they still need to take the placement test.
- If accommodations for a disability are needed, please contact the Accessibility Resource Office (ARO) at 636-481-3158 prior to taking the placement test. For questions about whether or not a placement test will be needed, contact the Office of Admissions at admissions@jeffco.edu or at 636-481-3235.

- 5** Meet with an Advising Specialist to register for classes.
