



Transfer Articulation Agreement Between:



Jefferson College
and
University College in Arts & Sciences
Washington University in St. Louis

Purpose of the Agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to build an educational pathway that leads to further student educational attainment and success.

Admission Requirements for the Receiving Institution

- A. The receiving institution's admissions requirements apply to students who transfer under this agreement.
- B. Students must fulfill all graduation requirements at both institutions.

Transfer of Credits and Credits Required within this Agreement

- A. The receiving institution will accept 66 credits from Jefferson College.
- B. Courses will transfer according to the attached Recommended Academic Plan (Addendum).
- C. Total additional credits required at the receiving institution to complete the baccalaureate degree: 54.
- D. Both institutions will honor all existing reverse transfer agreements.

Terms of Agreement and Review

- A. The designees of both Jefferson College and the receiving institution will implement the terms of this agreement.
- B. Review of this agreement will be done every 3 years.
- C. This agreement will remain in effect until discontinued with written notice by either or both institutions.
- D. Both Jefferson College and the receiving institution agree to communicate program changes in writing to avoid disruption to student success. This communication should include a revised Transfer Guide with highlighted changes from the institution reporting the change(s).
- E. The receiving institution agrees to provide Jefferson College with both the number and percentage of students who achieve degree completion at the receiving institution on an annual basis.
- F. Both Jefferson College and the receiving institutions agree to communicate with common and respective publics concerning this established agreement between the two institutions.

Special Notations

This agreement becomes effective on the 2nd day of January, 2018.
