JEFFERSON COLLEGE VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY

The 2024 Veterinary Technology class will be selected based on the completion of the following requirements. You will receive a file review by the Veterinary Technology Admissions Committee after you have successfully completed these requirements. Final date for the completion of admission criteria is March 31, 2024, with exception to the prerequisite courses. Individuals must have completed the prerequisites or be currently enrolled in these courses in the spring or summer 2024 semesters to be accepted into the Veterinary Technology program (pending final grades).

Veterinary Technology Admissions Process, Fall 2024

1. Apply for general admission to Jefferson College.

- Submit a free online application.
- Please Note: Acceptance to the college does not guarantee admission to the Veterinary Technology program.

2. Complete and return a Veterinary Technology Supplemental Application.

- In addition to the application, a \$30 Veterinary Technology application fee must be paid at the cashier, located in the Student Center. A copy of the paid receipt must be included in the Veterinary Technology Supplemental Application for the application to be considered complete. If a paid receipt is not received, the applicant's file will not be reviewed for admission to the Veterinary Technology Program.
- These will be accepted beginning October 1, 2023 through March 31, 2024. Please complete the form accurately and completely so we can process your application. This application is valid for **one year only**.
- Veterinary Technology Supplemental Applications **must** be returned directly to the Veterinary Technology Department via mail or email to dnevois@jeffco.edu.

3. Submit an official copy of your high school transcript.

- Contact your high school to send a complete transcript to the Department of Enrollment Services at Jefferson College. If you are currently enrolled in high school, mail a copy of your current transcript. Only core classes (English, math, and science) will be considered when reviewing the high school transcript. You must have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or above in core classes to receive a file review. Additionally, you will need to request that your high school send a completed transcript after you graduate.
 - o If you have completed 12 or more college credits that will apply to the Veterinary Technology degree, you do not need to submit an official copy of your high school transcript **UNLESS** you plan to use high school biology and chemistry as prerequisites for the Veterinary Technology Program.
- Request that the Registrar's Office of all colleges you have attended send us an official transcript. Only core classes that will apply to the Veterinary Technology degree (required general education and science courses) will be considered when reviewing college transcripts. To view the required courses, please refer to the Veterinary Technology Degree Plan. You must have a cumulative college GPA of 2.50 or above in these classes to receive a file review.
- At this time, the Veterinary Technology Program does not accept the transfer of veterinary technology specific coursework from other programs. Credit may be eligible for elective credit as assigned by Jefferson College. Please see an academic advisor for more information regarding transfer credit.

4. Completion of the Veterinary Technology program prerequisites.

• Prerequisites for the program are high school biology and chemistry **OR** college level biology, <u>taken and</u> <u>completed with a grade "C" or above within the last five years.</u> These classes must have had a lab accompany them. You are required to notify the veterinary technology department of prerequisite courses taken during the spring and summer 2024 semesters in order to have a completed file for review.

5. Completion and verification of 16 hours of veterinary clinical shadowing/observation hours OR employment in a veterinary practice that employs at least one Registered Veterinary Technician.

- Applicants are required to perform and document 16 hours of veterinary clinical shadowing/observation/employment hours in order to have a completed file for review.
- The applicant is responsible for completing and submitting the observation form provided in the supplemental application packet to the Veterinary Technology department no later than March 31, 2023.
- The applicant is responsible for writing a brief narrative (250-300 words) summarizing the
 observation/shadowing experience that specifically focuses on the role of the veterinary technician in the
 veterinary profession.

6. Two professional or academic references (form letters of recommendations) must be on file.

- You will need to provide two professional or academic references; no family members, friends, neighbors, or
 pastors please. The names and addresses of your references should be included on the Veterinary Technology
 Supplemental Application.
- The references listed are responsible for submitting the form letters of recommendation provided in the supplemental application packet to the Veterinary Technology department no later than March 31, 2024.

7. Veterinary Technology file reviews.

• The Veterinary Technology Admissions Committee meets to review applications in April of each year. All requirements must be completed by March 31 to be considered for the file review for the fall semester. ONLY COMPLETE FILES WILL BE REVIEWED. During the file review, the Veterinary Technology Admissions Committee reviews current GPA (high school GPA will be used unless the applicant has completed 12 or more hours of college credit), prerequisite completion, general education and/or science coursework completion, prior work experience, and professional/academic references. A maximum number of 36-48 students will be accepted into the Veterinary Technology Program. Letters will be sent to all applicants informing them of the committee's decision.

8. The Veterinary Technology Admissions Committee consists of:

- The Director of the Veterinary Technology Program
- Two Full-Time Faculty Members of the Veterinary Technology Program
- Non-Veterinary Technology Member in the Educational Field

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Veterinary Technology Admission Rubric and Instructions

The Veterinary Technology Program is equipped to accept 36 students for the 2024-2026 cohort. Applications are reviewed after the application deadline has passed. Each application is scored based on the points system indicated below. The 36 applicants who earn the highest scores are admitted into the Veterinary Technology Program. The Program also maintains an alternate list of applicants who can be offered a position into the Program should one of the originally accepted students decline the position offered to them. There is not a waiting list for entrance into the program. Students not accepted into the program or alternates who do not fill a vacated position need to reapply at the next application period.
