# **HESI Mobility Entrance Exam**

# **Minimum HESI Mobility Score Requirements**

To be considered for admission, a candidate must earn a minimum of **850** (or higher) on the exam.

- HESI's recommended level of performance is **900 and above** for all scores provided.
  - Applicant HESI Mobility scores currently range from 850 to 1229.
  - $\circ$  HESI Mobility scores range from 0 1,000 and can be as high as 1,500 (depending on the difficulty level of the exam).
- The minimum (or higher) score requirement MUST be met in order to be eligible to apply to the nursing program (no exceptions).

#### **Exam Fee**

HESI Mobility exam fee of **\$72**. The exam fee may be paid at the cashier's window in the Student Center, main floor (Hillsboro Campus) *or* the Arnold front desk - 1<sup>st</sup> floor.

#### **Exam Dates**

The exam may be taken <u>one (1) time</u> during the testing period of **January 1 – June 30**, and <u>one (1) time</u> during the testing period of **July 1 – December 31**, for a maximum of twice per year (<u>no exceptions</u>).

- If an applicant does not pass the exam, the applicant will have to wait until the next testing period to retake the exam (<u>no exceptions</u>).
  - The nursing department will accept the higher score
- Jefferson College will **not** accept test scores taken **prior to the six-month waiting period**, regardless of the score obtained.
- There is no limit to how many times the exam can be taken; **however**, the HESI exam may only be taken twice within a calendar year (see above).

#### **Exam Deadline**

HESI Mobility scores are due on the application for admission due date; scores must be turned in with the completed application.

### **Exam Locations**

The HESI Mobility exam may be taken at the Jefferson College Hillsboro and Arnold Testing Centers (TC). Allow 3 hours to complete the exam. Bring a valid photo ID to testing. Testing supplies will be issued, including paper and pencil, a calculator is embedded in the testing

software.

#### **Score Validation**

The HESI Mobility score is valid for <u>two (2) years **prior**</u> to the <u>program start date</u> (not the application due date) the applicant is applying for.

# For example:

- The <u>evening</u> nursing program begins in January XX, 2025; the HESI exam must have been taken *no earlier* than January XX, 2023.
- The <u>day</u> nursing program begins in August XX, 2025; the HESI exam must have been taken *no earlier* than August XX, 2023.

HESI Mobility taken elsewhere and within two (2) years may be transferred to Jefferson College by contacting HESI Customer Service at 1-800-222-9570 and paying the testing transfer fee.
