Course Description:

This 4-hour course begins with an overview for the students to digest the difference between who they are before they begin their law enforcement careers and who they become after such.

The instructor will encourage the student to discuss the risks involved related to the inherent mental health trauma sustained over the course of their careers.

The course culminates with how to become self-aware of their trauma, how to begin developing a plan towards overcoming their grief and/or trauma, and how to seek help and/or professional mental health services.
