# Board of Trustees Action

At the October meeting of the Board of Trustees, approval was given for more than \$338,000 in technology equipment for classrooms, faculty and staff. The package includes 177 personal computers, 132 monitors, 77 Chromebooks, 77 laptops plus four iMacs, 15 Smartboards, three document cameras, two charging carts, and 13 eSports desktop computers and monitors.

The Board also approved new directional signs for the Farm Road entrance to the Hillsboro campus. The new signs will direct visitors to the softball field parking, Observatory, future Fire Service facilities and other areas as the property is developed. The design of the two signs will match current structures. Piros Signs of Barnhart was awarded the contract for \$44,377 to create and install the signage.
